7 **A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute an intergovernmental agreement**
8 **with the City of Akron concerning per capita funding for the purchase and maintenance of**
9 **vehicles and equipment for the Summit County Special Operations Response Teams, for**
10 **the Executive's Department of Law, Insurance and Risk Management-Division of Public**
11 **Safety-Emergency Management Agency, and declaring an emergency.**

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13 WHEREAS, the County maintains the Summit County Emergency Management
14 Agency ("SCEMA"), which is funded by monies paid to the County by political
15 subdivisions within the County pursuant to an Emergency Management Agency Agreement;
16 and

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18 WHEREAS, the City of Akron houses various vehicles and equipment purchased by
19 the SCEMA and used by the Special Operations Response Teams ("SORT"), and performs
20 routine preventive maintenance on these SORT vehicles and equipment; and

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22 WHEREAS, the City of Akron and County agreed to have one-third (1/3) of the per
23 capita funding collected from the City of Akron under the Emergency Management
24 Agreement returned to the Akron Fire Department to purchase and maintain the SORT
25 vehicles and equipment; and

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27 WHEREAS, the Summit County Emergency Management Executive Committee has
28 approved these expenditures in the 2016 and 2017 calendar year budgets; and

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30 WHEREAS, it is necessary for the parties to execute an intergovernmental
31 agreement to set forth the rights and duties of the parties concerning the funds paid by
32 the County to City of Akron; and

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34 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
35 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the Executive to
36 execute an intergovernmental agreement with the City of Akron concerning per capita funding
37 for the purchase and maintenance of vehicles and equipment for the Summit County Special
38 Operations Response Teams;

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40 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
41 of Ohio, that:

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43 SECTION 1

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45 The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute any documents necessary to enter
46 into an intergovernmental agreement with the City of Akron concerning per capita funding for
47 the purchase and maintenance of vehicles and equipment for the Summit County Special
48 Operations Response Teams ("SORT"). The Executive is hereby authorized to execute the
49 intergovernmental agreement with the City of Akron in a form substantially similar to the one
50 attached to this Resolution as Exhibit A.

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4 SECTION 2

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6 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
7 welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit and for the further reason to immediately
8 authorize the Executive to execute a necessary intergovernmental agreement in order to continue
9 to provide necessary services and support for the SORT.

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11 SECTION 3

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13 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
14 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
15 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

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17 SECTION 4

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19 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating
20 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all
21 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,
22 were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section
23 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
