7 **A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to advertise for Self-Contained Breathing**  
8 **Apparatus (“SCBA”) and/or SCBA accessories for four Region 5 Hazardous Material**  
9 **Teams, for an estimated total cost not to exceed \$198,901.00, for the Executive’s**  
10 **Department of Law, Insurance and Risk Management-Division of Public Safety-**  
11 **Emergency Management Agency, and declaring an emergency.**

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13 WHEREAS, Section 177.05 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit  
14 requires this Council’s authorization for the County Executive to advertise for bids; and

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16 WHEREAS, the County Executive wishes to advertise for bids for Self-Contained  
17 Breathing Apparatus (“SCBA”) and/or SCBA accessories for the following four Region 5  
18 Hazardous Material Teams located in Columbiana, Medina, Portage and Stark Counties, for an  
19 estimated total cost not to exceed \$198,901.00; and

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21 WHEREAS, a copy of the bid specifications is on file in the Clerk of Council’s office;

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24 WHEREAS this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information  
25 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the Executive to  
26 advertise for bids for the aforementioned SCBA and/or SCBA accessories;

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28 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State  
29 of Ohio, that:

31 SECTION 1

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33 The County Executive is authorized to advertise for bids for Self-Contained Breathing  
34 Apparatus and/or accessories for the following four Region 5 Hazardous Material Teams located  
35 in Columbiana, Medina, Portage and Stark Counties, for an estimated total cost not to exceed  
36 \$198,901.00.

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38 SECTION 2

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40 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and  
41 welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason that it authorizes the  
42 Executive to advertise for bids for the aforementioned necessary equipment for the Region 5  
43 Hazardous Materials Teams in a timely manner.

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45 SECTION 3

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47 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take  
48 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take  
49 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.  
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
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SECTION 4
