7 **A Resolution declaring July 27th, 2017 as Multiple Sclerosis Awareness Day in Summit**
8 **County, and encouraging the residents of Summit County to join in walking during the**
9 **Summit County Walks for MS on that day, for the Executive, and declaring an emergency.**

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11 WHEREAS, multiple sclerosis (“MS”) is an unpredictable and disabling disease that
12 impacts over 2.3 million people globally; and

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14 WHEREAS, through awareness campaigns, people living with MS are able to notice the
15 signs and symptoms of this illness thereby ensuring that they seek and receive the treatment that
16 they need to increase their quality of life; and

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18 WHEREAS, the County Executive will be hosting a walk on July 27th, 2017 in order to
19 raise money and awareness for those suffering from MS; and

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21 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
22 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit that July 27th, 2017 be
23 declared Multiple Sclerosis Awareness Month in Summit County, and encouraging the residents
24 of Summit County to join in this acknowledgement and participate in the Summit County Walks
25 for MS on the same day;

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27 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
28 of Ohio, that:

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30 SECTION 1

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32 July 27, 2017 is hereby declared Multiple Sclerosis Awareness Day in Summit County
33 and encouraging the residents of Summit County to join in this acknowledgement.

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35 SECTION 2

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37 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
38 welfare of the citizens and employees of the County of Summit and for the further purpose of
39 immediately declaring said day as MS Awareness Day before the deadline to register for the
40 walk.

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42 SECTION 3

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44 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight (8) members, it shall take
45 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise it shall take effect
46 and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

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SECTION 4

It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
