7 **A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute assignment agreements with**
8 **Hattie Larlham Community Services, Tri-County Jobs for Ohio's Graduates and the**
9 **Akron Community Service Center and Urban League, Inc. and the Summit and Medina**
10 **Workforce Area Council of Governments to assign certain duties of the County of Summit**
11 **to the Council under Workforce Investment Opportunity Act youth agreements with said**
12 **providers for out-of-school and in-and-out of school services, for the period 7/1/17 through**
13 **6/30/18, for the Executive's Department of Job and Family Services, and declaring an**
14 **emergency.**

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16 WHEREAS, the State of Ohio has established local workforce areas to provide workforce
17 development activities described under the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act of 2014
18 and has designated Summit and Medina Counties as Workforce Area 2; and

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20 WHEREAS, County Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2016-326, which
21 authorized the County Executive to execute an intergovernmental agreement with Medina
22 County to create the Summit and Medina Workforce Area Council of Governments ("SAMWA
23 COG"), to execute bylaws for said SAMWA COG and to execute a Local Governance
24 Agreement for Local Workforce Development Area 2; and

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26 WHEREAS, the SAMWA COG is the organizational vehicle and governance structure
27 for Workforce Area 2 through which the COG board, comprised of county elected officials,
28 exercises local oversight of Workforce Development activities through its staff; and

30 WHEREAS, Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2017-201, which confirmed an
31 award by the Board of Control of a renewal (second and final) of professional service contracts
32 with Hattie Larlham Community Services, Tri-County Jobs for Ohio's Graduates and the Akron
33 Community Service Center and Urban League, Inc. for Workforce Innovation and Opportunity
34 Act ("WIOA") youth agreements, to provide for out-of-school and in-and-out-of-school youth
35 employment and educational services, for the period 7/1/17 through 6/30/18, in a total amount
36 not to exceed \$652,000.00; and

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38 WHEREAS, Hattie Larlham Community Services, Tri-County Jobs for Ohio's
39 Graduates, the Akron Community Service Center and Urban League, Inc. and the SAMWA
40 COG have agreed to execute assignment agreements with the County to assign certain duties of
41 the County of Summit to the SAMWA COG under the aforementioned WIOA youth agreements,
42 for the period 7/1/17 through 6/30/18; and

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44 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
45 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize and execute the
46 assignment agreements with Hattie Larlham Community Services, Tri-County Jobs for Ohio's
47 Graduates and the Akron Community Service Center and Urban League, Inc. and the Summit
48 and Medina Workforce Area Council of Governments to assign certain duties of the County of
49 Summit to the Council under Workforce Investment Opportunity Act youth agreements with said
50 providers for out-of-school and in-and-out of school services, for the period 7/1/17 through
51 6/30/18;

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4 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
5 of Ohio, that:

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7 SECTION 1

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9 The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute assignment agreements with Hattie
10 Larlham Community Services, Tri-County Jobs for Ohio's Graduates and the Akron Community
11 Service Center and Urban League, Inc. and the Summit and Medina Workforce Area Council of
12 Governments ("SAMWA COG") to assign certain duties of the County of Summit to the
13 SAMWA COG under Workforce Investment Opportunity Act ("WOIA") youth agreements with
14 said providers for out-of-school and in-and-out of school services, for the period 7/1/17 through
15 6/30/18. The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute said assignment agreements in
16 substantially the form attached to this Resolution as Exhibits A, B and C.

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18 SECTION 2

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20 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
21 welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason that it necessary to
22 immediately authorize the Executive to execute the assignment agreements with the
23 aforementioned providers and the SAMWA COG so that certain duties of the County may be
24 immediately performed by the SAMWA COG during the term of the WOIA youth agreements
25 commencing 7/1/17.

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27 SECTION 3

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29 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
30 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
31 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

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33 SECTION 4

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35 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating
36 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all
37 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,
38 were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section
39 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
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
