A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute a one-year intergovernmental agreement with the County of Summit Alcohol, Drug Addiction & Mental Health Services Board for the County Sheriff's Office to provide non-Medicaid behavioral health services through its Drug Abuse Resistance Education unit to the Board, for the period 7/1/17 through 6/30/18, for payment to the County in a total amount not to exceed \$86,900.00, for the Sheriff, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the County of Summit Alcohol, Drug Addiction & Mental Health Services ("ADM") Board wishes to execute a one-year intergovernmental agreement with the County for the County Sheriff's Office to provide non-Medicaid behavioral health services through its Drug Abuse Resistance Education ("D.A.R.E.") unit to the ADM Board, for the period 7/1/17 through 6/30/18, for which the ADM Board has agreed to pay the County a total amount not to exceed \$86,900.00 during the term of the agreement; and

WHEREAS, the County wishes to provide said services to the ADM Board through the D.A.R.E. unit; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information. that the aforementioned intergovernmental agreement is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that;

SECTION I

The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute a one-year intergovernmental agreement with the County of Summit Alcohol, Drug Addiction & Mental Health Services ("ADM") Board for the County Sheriff's Office to provide non-Medicaid behavioral health services through its Drug Abuse Resistance Education unit to the ADM Board, for the period 7/1/17 through 6/30/18, for payment to the County in a total amount not to exceed \$86,900.00 during the term of the agreement. The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute the intergovernmental agreement in substantially the form attached to this Resolution as Exhibit A.

SECTION 2

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit and for the further purpose of immediately authorizing the Sheriff's Office to provide non-Medicaid behavioral health services through its D.A.R.E. unit to the ADM Board in 2017 and 2018 commencing 7/1/17.

SECTION 3

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.
