A Resolution increasing appropriations, in the amount of \$20,000.00, in the Juvenile Court's Family Drug Court Implementation grant, for Court of Common Pleas-Juvenile Division, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, County Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2013-438, which authorized the County Executive to execute any documents necessary to accept an award from the U.S. Department of Justice, Office of Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention of a Family Drug Court Implementation Project grant for the Court of Common Pleas-Juvenile Division, for the Fiscal Years 2014 through 2016, in the amount of \$538,363.00, with no local cash match requirement, and appropriated said grant funds for the period of 10/1/13 through 9/30/16; and

WHEREAS, Council subsequently adopted Resolution No. 2016-319, which adjusted existing appropriations, in the amount of \$32,892.17, within the Family Drug Court Implementation Project (the "Project") in order to implement a one-year extension of the Project, for the period 10/1/16 through 9/30/17; and

WHEREAS, the actual costs of the Project are \$558,363.00; and

WHEREAS, the Juvenile Court wishes to use Helping Ohioans Move, Expanding Choice grant funds to make up for the \$20,000.00 shortfall; and

WHEREAS this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that increasing appropriations, in the amount of \$20,000.00, for the Project is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Summit, State of Ohio, that:
