7 **An Ordinance amending Section 775.03 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of**
8 **Summit, entitled “License Application and Requirements,” to require itinerant vendors,**
9 **hawkers, peddlers, solicitors and canvassers selling perishable food products to provide**
10 **proof that they have obtained a certificate from the appropriate health department for**
11 **their operation, for the Department of Law, Insurance and Risk Management-Office of**
12 **Consumer Affairs, and declaring an emergency.**

13
14 WHEREAS, Section 775.03 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit,
15 entitled “License Application and Requirements,” requires itinerant vendors, hawkers, peddlers,
16 solicitors, and canvassers to provide certain information to the Executive’s Department of Law,
17 Insurance and Risk Management-Office of Consumer Affairs and obtain a license for their
18 operation in Summit County; and

19
20 WHEREAS, in order to protect the health of consumers in Summit County, it is
21 necessary to amend Section 775.03 to require itinerant vendors, hawkers, peddlers, solicitors, or
22 canvassers selling perishable food products to provide proof that they have obtained a certificate
23 from the appropriate health department for their operation; and

25 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
26 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to amend Section 775.03 for
27 the aforementioned reason;

29 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
30 of Ohio, that:

32 SECTION 1

34 Section 775.03 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit, entitled “License
35 Application and Requirements,” is hereby amended as set forth in Exhibit A, attached to this
36 Ordinance and incorporated herein as if fully restated.

38 SECTION 2

40 This Ordinance is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and
41 welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit and for the further reason that it is necessary to
42 immediately amend Section 775.03 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit to
43 protect the health of consumers in Summit County.

45 SECTION 3

47 Provided this Ordinance received the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
48 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
49 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.
