WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held on August 30, 2017, awarded a general encumbrance purchase order for deputy uniform allowances for Fiscal Year 2017, per Article 27 of the Deputies Bargaining Agreement, attached to this Resolution as Exhibit A, with any vendor approved by the Sheriff's Office Uniform Allowance Committee, in a total amount not to exceed \$225,000.00, subject to confirmation by County Council; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information that the general encumbrance for the aforementioned purpose is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1

The award by the Board of Control of a general encumbrance for deputy uniform allowances for Fiscal Year 2017, per Article 27 of the Deputies Bargaining Agreement, attached to this Resolution as Exhibit A, with any vendor approved by the Sheriff's Office Uniform Allowance Committee, in a total amount not to exceed \$225,000.00 is hereby confirmed. The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute a purchase contract with any vendor approved by the Sheriff's Office Uniform Allowance Committee.

SECTION 2

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit and for the further reason to immediately provide for a general encumbrance purchase order for deputy uniform allowances for Fiscal Year 2017.

SECTION 3

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.
