7 **A Resolution confirming an award by the Board of Control of a general encumbrance**
8 **purchase order for deputy uniform allowances for Fiscal Year 2017 with any vendor**
9 **approved by the Sheriff's Office Uniform Allowance Committee, in a total amount not to**
10 **exceed \$225,000.00, for the Sheriff, and declaring an emergency.**

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12 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held on August 30, 2017, awarded a
13 general encumbrance purchase order for deputy uniform allowances for Fiscal Year 2017, per
14 Article 27 of the Deputies Bargaining Agreement, attached to this Resolution as Exhibit A, with
15 any vendor approved by the Sheriff's Office Uniform Allowance Committee, in a total amount
16 not to exceed \$225,000.00, subject to confirmation by County Council; and

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18 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information
19 that the general encumbrance for the aforementioned purpose is necessary and in the best interest
20 of the County of Summit;

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22 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the County of Summit, State
23 of Ohio, that:

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25 SECTION 1

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27 The award by the Board of Control of a general encumbrance for deputy uniform
28 allowances for Fiscal Year 2017, per Article 27 of the Deputies Bargaining Agreement, attached
29 to this Resolution as Exhibit A, with any vendor approved by the Sheriff's Office Uniform
30 Allowance Committee, in a total amount not to exceed \$225,000.00 is hereby confirmed. The
31 County Executive is hereby authorized to execute a purchase contract with any vendor approved
32 by the Sheriff's Office Uniform Allowance Committee.

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34 SECTION 2

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36 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
37 welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit and for the further reason to immediately
38 provide for a general encumbrance purchase order for deputy uniform allowances for Fiscal Year
39 2017.

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41 SECTION 3

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43 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
44 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
45 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

51 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,
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
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


