## SECTION 1

The award by the Board of Control of a professional service contract with the Akron Community Service Center and Urban League, Inc. to provide Career Pathways program services for adults ages 25 and older, including ex-offenders and non-offenders, for a one-year term, from 10/1/17 through 9/30/18, with one option to renew for an additional one-year term, in an amount not to exceed \$175,000.00, is hereby confirmed and the County Executive is hereby authorized such professional service contract.
