7 **A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute an agreement and any other**
8 **documents necessary for an inter-county transfer of funds between the Executive's**
9 **Department of Job and Family Services and the Franklin County Department of Job and**
10 **Family Services, pursuant to which agreement Summit County will transfer \$250,000.00 in**
11 **Federal Fiscal Year 2017 Temporary Assistance to Needy Families Regular funds to**
12 **Franklin County, for the Executive's Department of Job and Family Services, and**
13 **declaring an emergency.**

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15 Section 5101:9-6-82 of the Ohio Administrative Code authorizes counties to execute a
16 JFS 02719 "Inter-county Agreement and Certification Release and Acceptance of Funds" to
17 engage in inter-county transfers of funds allocated to county departments of job and family
18 services by the Ohio Department of Job and Family Services; and

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20 WHEREAS, Section 5101:9-6-82(F)(2)(b) provides that a board of county
21 commissioners may assign authority to another party to serve as designee and therefore, grant
22 that party authority to sign an inter-county adjustment agreement on behalf of the county for a
23 specific period of time; and

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25 WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2017-214, which authorizes
26 the County Executive to execute the JFS 02719 Inter-county Agreement and Certification
27 Release and Acceptance of Funds, and any other documents necessary pursuant to Section
28 5101:9-6-82 for the acceptance by the County Executive's Department of Job and Family
29 Services ("SCDJFS") of inter-county transfers of funds from other Ohio counties, for the period
30 6/14/17 through 6/30/19, and assigns the Executive as designee of the County of Summit to
31 execute said agreements and documents as provided in Section 5101:9-6-82(F)(2)(b), for the
32 period 6/14/17 through 6/30/19; and

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34 WHEREAS, Summit County and Franklin County wish to enter into an agreement
35 pursuant to Section 5101:9-6-82 pursuant to which SCDJFS will transfer \$250,000.00 in Federal
36 Fiscal Year 2017 ("FFY17") Temporary Assistance to Needy Families ("TANF") Regular funds
37 to the Franklin County Department of Job and Family Services ("FCDJS") in exchange for
38 \$250,000.00 in FFY17 Title XX TANF funds, which will provide greater flexibility for the
39 SCDJS's contracts with providers; and

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41 WHEREAS, while Resolution No. 2017-214 authorizes the Executive to accept the
42 transfer of funds to SCDJFS, it is necessary to authorize the Executive to execute an agreement
43 and any other documents necessary for the inter-county transfer of said \$250,000.00 in FFY17
44 TANF Regular funds to FCDJS; and

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46 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
47 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the Executive to
48 execute the JFS 02719 Inter-county Agreement and Certification Release and Acceptance of
49 Funds, and any other documents necessary pursuant to Section 5101:9-6-82 for the transfer of
50 \$250,000.00 in FFY17 TANF Regular funds to FCDJS;

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4 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
5 of Ohio, that:

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7 SECTION 1

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9 The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute the JFS 02719 Inter-county
10 Agreement and Certification Release and Acceptance of Funds, and any other documents
11 necessary pursuant to Section 5101:9-6-82 for the transfer by the Executive's Department of Job
12 and Family Services ("SCDJFS") of \$250,000.00 in Federal Fiscal Year 2017 ("FFY17")
13 Temporary Assistance to Needy Families ("TANF") Regular funds to the Franklin County
14 Department of Job and Family Services ("FCDJFS").

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16 SECTION 2

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18 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
19 welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit and for the further reason to immediately
20 authorize the transfer by SCDJS of FFY17 TANF regular funds to FCDJFS in exchange for
21 FFY17 TANF Title XX funds in order to immediately provide greater flexibility for the SCDJS's
22 contracts with providers.

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24 SECTION 3

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26 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
27 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
28 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

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30 SECTION 4

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32 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating
33 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all
34 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,
35 were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section
36 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
