7 **A Resolution confirming an award by the Board of Control of a professional service**  
8 **contract with Perfecting Saints Heart to Heart Ministries, Inc. to provide employment**  
9 **services focused on adult ex-offender needs, for a one-year term, from 10/1/17 through**  
10 **9/30/18, in an amount not to exceed \$120,000.00, for the Executive's Department of Job and**  
11 **Family Services, and declaring an emergency.**

13 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held September 6, 2017, awarded a  
14 professional service contract with Perfecting Saints Heart to Heart Ministries, Inc. to provide  
15 employment services focused on adult ex-offender needs, for a one-year term, from 10/1/17  
16 through 9/30/18, in an amount not to exceed \$120,000.00, subject to confirmation by County  
17 Council; and

19 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information  
20 that the aforementioned professional service contract with Perfecting Saints Heart to Heart  
21 Ministries, Inc. is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

23 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State  
24 of Ohio, that:

28 The award by the Board of Control of a professional service contract with Perfecting  
29 Saints Heart to Heart Ministries, Inc. to provide employment services focused on adult ex-  
30 offender needs, for a one-year term, from 10/1/17 through 9/30/18, in an amount not to exceed  
31 \$120,000.00, is hereby confirmed and the County Executive is hereby authorized to execute such  
32 professional service contract.

36 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and  
37 welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately  
38 provide for employment services focused on adult ex-offender needs effective 10/1/17.

42 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take  
43 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take  
44 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.


