WHEREAS, the City of Akron further desires to make significant repairs and improvements to the City's roadways to address the needs of residents and motorists throughout

WHEREAS, the City of Akron has committed that all proceeds of the additional tax will be used to fund the Akron Police Department, Akron Fire Department and roadway

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information. that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to express support for Issue 4, and to urge the citizens of Akron to vote YES on Issue 4 in the November 7, 2017 General

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit. State

This Council expresses its support for Issue 4, an additional 1/4 percent levy on income in the City of Akron, and urges the citizens of Akron to vote YES on Issue 4 in the November 7

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason of immediately expressing support for Issue 4, prior to the commencement of early voting for the November 7 2017 General Election.
