7 **A Resolution accepting the amounts and rates as determined by the Budget Commission,**
8 **authorizing the necessary tax levies and certifying them for the year 2018 to the County**
9 **Fiscal Officer, for the Executive's Department of Finance and Budget, and declaring an**
10 **emergency.**

12 WHEREAS, the Budget Commission of the County of Summit has certified its action
13 thereon to this Council together with an estimate by the County Fiscal Officer of the rate of each
14 tax necessary to be levied by this Council, and what part thereof is without, and what part is
15 within, the ten mill tax limitation; and

17 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
18 that accepting the amount and rates determined by the Budget Commission, authorizing the
19 necessary tax levies and certifying them for the year 2018 to the Fiscal Officer is necessary and
20 in the best interest of the County of Summit;

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22 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
23 of Ohio, that:

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25 SECTION 1

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27 The amounts and rates as determined by the Budget Commission in its certification,
28 attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein as if fully restated, are hereby accepted.
29 There is hereby levied on the tax duplicate of the County of Summit the rate of each tax
30 necessary to be levied within and without the ten mill limitation.

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32 SECTION 2

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34 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
35 welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit and for the further reason that it is necessary to
36 comply in a timely manner with requirements by the State of Ohio that County Council accept
37 the rates as determined by the Budget Commission and authorize the necessary tax levies for
38 2017 and certify them to the County Fiscal Officer.

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40 SECTION 3

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42 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
43 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
44 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.


