7 **A Resolution confirming an award by the Board of Control of a purchase contract with**
8 **Warren Fire Equipment, Inc. for Self-Contained Breathing Apparatus (SCBA) and**
9 **Accessories for Type II HazMat Teams, in an amount not to exceed \$166,070.00, for the**
10 **Executive's Department of Law, Insurance and Risk Management-Division of Public**
11 **Safety-Emergency Management Agency, and declaring an emergency.**

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13 WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2017-257, which authorized
14 the County Executive to advertise for Self-Contained Breathing Apparatus (SCBA) and
15 Accessories for Type II HazMat Teams, for an estimated total cost not to exceed \$198,901.00;

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18 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held September 6, 2017, awarded a
19 purchase contract with Warren Fire Equipment, Inc. for Self-Contained Breathing Apparatus
20 (SCBA) and Accessories for Type II HazMat Teams, in an amount not to exceed \$166,070.00,
21 subject to confirmation by County Council; and

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23 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
24 that the aforementioned purchase contract with Warren Fire Equipment, Inc. is necessary and in
25 the best interest of the County of Summit;

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27 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
28 of Ohio, that:

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30 SECTION 1

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32 The award by the Board of Control of a purchase contract with Warren Fire Equipment,
33 Inc. for Self-Contained Breathing Apparatus (SCBA) and Accessories for Type II HazMat
34 Teams, in an amount not to exceed \$166,070.00, is hereby confirmed and the County Executive
35 is hereby authorized to execute such purchase contract.

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37 SECTION 2

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39 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of health, safety and
40 welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately
41 provide necessary equipment for the Type II HazMat Teams.

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45 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
46 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
47 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.
