7 **A Resolution establishing the County Medicaid Local Sales Tax Transition Fund for the**
8 **receipt of State Transitional Aid as directed by Ohio Am. Sub. H.B. No. 49, appropriating**
9 **said transitional aid funds, and authorizing the Executive to transfer said transitional aid**
10 **funds to the General Fund, for the Executive's Department of Finance and Budget, and**
11 **declaring an emergency.**

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13 WHEREAS, the State of Ohio biennial budget for fiscal years 2018-2019 (Am. Sub.
14 House Bill 49 of the 132nd General Assembly) replaces the sales tax on Medicaid Manage Care
15 Organizations (MCOs) with an assessment on health insuring corporations that will result in the
16 loss of over \$200 million annually in revenue for counties and transit authorities; and

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18 WHEREAS, Am. Sub. House Bill 49 of the 132nd General Assembly also includes a
19 one-time allocation of \$207 million in state fiscal year 2018 for a Medicaid Local Sales Tax
20 Transition Fund to partially mitigate the loss of this annual revenue; and

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22 WHEREAS, Division (C) of temporary law provision 387.20 (Medicaid Local Sales Tax
23 Transition Fund) of Am. Sub. H.B. No. 49 requires each county and transit authority to establish
24 a County Medicaid Sales Tax Transition Fund by October 15, 2017 for the purpose of receiving
25 distributions of transitional aid; and

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27 WHEREAS, Division (C) of temporary law provision 387.20 (Medicaid Local Sales Tax
28 Transition Fund) of Am. Sub. H.B. No. 49 establishes Summit County's share of State
29 Transitional Aid as \$2,309,202.00;

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31 WHEREAS, it is further necessary to appropriate and authorize the transfer of said funds
32 to the General Fund from the Medicaid Local Sales Tax Transition Fund; and

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34 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
35 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County to establish the Medicaid Local Sales
36 Tax Transition Fund, to appropriate the same, and to transfer said funds to the General Fund.

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38 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State

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6 The County Fiscal Officer is hereby authorized and directed to effect the within
7 appropriations and establish fund 10005 - County Medicaid Sales Tax Transition Fund.

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9 SECTION 3

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11 The County Executive is hereby authorized to transfer State Transitional Aid funds from
12 the County Medicaid Sales Tax Transition Fund to the General Fund in amounts totaling
13 \$824,713 in FY 2017 and \$1,484,489 in FY 2018.

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15 SECTION 4

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17 This Resolution is declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare
18 of the citizens of the County of Summit and for the further purpose of immediately establishing
19 the County Medicaid Sales Tax Transition Fund for the receipt of State Transitional Aid as
20 directed by Ohio Am. Sub. H.B. No. 49, appropriating said transitional aid funds, and
21 authorizing the Executive to transfer said transitional aid funds to the General Fund.


