7 **A Resolution establishing the compensation of the County of Summit Human Resource**
8 **Commission members at an annual salary of \$8,580.00, with no fringe benefits, other than**
9 **the Ohio Public Employees Retirement System, effective December 25, 2017, to be paid in**
10 **26 equal payments, for the Executive, and declaring an emergency.**

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12 WHEREAS, pursuant to the Article VI, Section 6.01 of the County of Summit Charter,
13 County Council is authorized to review and establish the compensation for the members of the
14 Human Resource Commission ("HRC"); and

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16 WHEREAS, under Ohio law, the threshold for full participation in the Ohio Public
17 Employees Retirement System by HRC members has been increased, necessitating a
18 corresponding increase in their annual salary from \$8,190.00, which was set by Resolution No.
19 2017-077, to \$8,580.00; and

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21 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
22 that the compensation for HRC members should be established at an annual salary of \$8,580.00,
23 with no fringe benefits, other than the Ohio Public Employees Retirement System, effective
24 12/25/17, to be paid in 26 equal payments, for the aforementioned reason;

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26 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the County of Summit,
27 State of Ohio, that:

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29 SECTION 1

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31 Each member of the County of Summit Human Resource Commission ("HRC") shall be
32 compensated at an annual salary of \$8,580.00, with no fringe benefits, other than the Ohio Public
33 Employees Retirement System ("OPERS"), effective 12/25/17, to be paid in 26 equal payments.

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35 SECTION 2

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37 This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency in the interest of the health,
38 safety, and welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to
39 immediately establish fair compensation, effective 12/25/17, for the HRC members so that they
40 may fully participate in OPERS in 2018.

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42 SECTION 3

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44 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
45 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
46 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.
