A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute any documents necessary to accept the award from the State of Ohio Attorney General's Office of a Federal Fiscal Year 2018 Victims of Crime Act grant, in the amount of \$456,859.88, with a 20% local cash match requirement of \$114,214.97, and a Federal Fiscal Year 201 State Victims Assistance Act grant, in the amount of \$3,470.00, with no local cash match requirement, both for the period of 10/1/17 through 9/30/18, and appropriating funds, for the Prosecutor, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the County Prosecutor has received an award from the State of Ohio Attorney General's Office of a Federal Fiscal Year ("FFY") 2018 Victims of Crime Act ("VOCA") grant in the amount of \$456,859.88, with a 20% local cash match requirement of \$114,214.97 to be paid from the Prosecutor-General Office General Fund, for the period 10/1/17 through 9/30/18; and

WHEREAS, the Prosecutor has also received an award from the State of Ohio Attorney General's Office of a FFY 2018 State Victims Assistance Act ("SVAA") grant, in the amount of \$3,470.00, with no local cash match requirement, for the period 10/1/17 through 9/30/18, and for which the State of Ohio Attorney General's Office requires an accounting identity separate from the VOCA award; and

WHEREAS, the VOCA and SVAA are annual grants which help to support salary and benefits for four full-time victim advocates, two part-time victim advocates, one full-time facility dog handler, and part of the salary and benefits for a full-time supervisor; and

WHEREAS, the Prosecutor provides for the required VOCA grant match within her annual budget; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the County Executive to execute any documents necessary to accept the aforementioned grants from the State of Ohio Attorney General's Office and to appropriate funds;
