7 **A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute any documents necessary to**  
8 **accept the award by the Ohio Department of Rehabilitation and Correction, Division of**  
9 **Parole and Community Sanctions of a Justice Reinvestment and Incentive Grant to reduce**  
10 **probation violations, in State Fiscal Years 2018 and 2019, in the amount of \$168,435.00,**  
11 **with no local cash match requirement, and appropriating funds for County Fiscal Year**  
12 **2018, for the Court of Common Pleas-Adult Probation Department, and declaring an**  
13 **emergency.**

15 WHEREAS, the Ohio Department of Rehabilitation and Correction, Division of Parole  
16 and Community Sanctions (“ODRC-DPCS”) has awarded the Court of Common Pleas-Adult  
17 Probation Department Justice Reinvestment and Incentive Grant to adopt policies and practices  
18 based upon current research to reduce probation violations, in State Fiscal Years 2018 and 2019,  
19 in the amount of \$168,435.00, with no local cash match requirement; and

21 WHEREAS, this Council has determined by reviewing all pertinent information that it is  
22 necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the Executive to execute  
23 any documents necessary to accept the award from ODRC-DPCS of the aforementioned Justice  
24 Reinvestment and Incentive Grant, and to appropriate grant funds;

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26 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State

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31 The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute any documents necessary to accept  
32 the award by the Ohio Department of Rehabilitation and Correction, Division of Parole and  
33 Community Sanctions (“ODRC-DPCS”) has awarded the Court of Common Pleas-Adult  
34 Probation Department Justice Reinvestment and Incentive Grant to adopt policies and practices  
35 based upon current research to reduce probation violations, in State Fiscal Years 2018 and 2019,  
36 in the amount of \$168,435.00, with no local cash match requirement.

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11 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and  
12 welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit and for the further reason to immediately  
13 authorize the acceptance of the award by the ODRC-DPCS of the aforementioned Justice  
14 Reinvestment and Incentive Grant in order for the grant funds to be immediately used.

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18 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take  
19 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take  
20 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

28 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


