A Resolution authorizing the closure of a portion of Everett Road, from Farmstead Road to Wheatley Road, to daily traffic, located in Bath, Richfield, and Boston Townships, in Council District 1, for the Engineer, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, Section 1.01 of the Summit County Charter vests in the County "the concurrent exercise ... of all or any powers vested in municipalities by the Ohio Constitution or by general law."

WHEREAS, the Ohio Supreme Court in *City of Cleveland v. City of Shaker Heights,* 30 Ohio St.3d 49 (1987) determined that municipalities may close through streets using their Home Rule powers, if done in good faith and for reasonable purposes; and

WHEREAS, for several months, the Council has been considering the vacation of this portion of Everett Road, located in Bath, Richfield, and Boston Townships, in Council District 1, due to conditions of the road and the corresponding cost to repair the same; and

WHEREAS, as this Council continues to consider whether to vacate this portion of Everett Road, it has determined that it is appropriate to close the same to daily traffic due to the condition of the road; and

WHEREAS, this Council has determined by reviewing all pertinent information that closing Everett Road from Farmstead Road to Wheatley Road, is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit for the reasons stated above;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1

Effective January 30, 2018, the County Engineer is authorized to close Everett Road from its intersection with Farmstead Road to its intersection with Wheatley Road located in Bath, Richfield, and Boston Townships, in Council District 1. All other portions of Everett Road will remain open. The County Engineer is further authorized and directed to cooperate with the local fire departments and districts near the portion of the closed road to provide emergency access to safety vehicles through the closed portion of Everett Road in the manner that the County Engineer deems appropriate and as soon as practical, provided that each department or district given access to the same signs an agreement whereby it holds the county harmless from any injury to property or person caused by use of the closed section of the road.

SECTION 2

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason that it promotes safe travel within the County of Summit.
