WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that the aforementioned professional service contract with Akron General Partners, Inc. is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

## SECTION 1
