An Ordinance establishing the unincorporated territory of Bath Township as a Service Area in the Summit County Surface Water Management District pursuant to Section 942.03 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit, and setting a rate of \$4.00 per Equivalent Rate Unit per month for the Surface Water Management Service Charge for the Bath Township Service Area, in accordance with Section 942.06 of the Codified Ordinances, beginning July 1, 2018, in Council Districts 4 and 5, for the Engineer and Council, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, in 2017, this Council adopted Ordinance 2017-282, thereby establishing Chapter 942 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit, entitled "Surface Water Management District;" and

WHEREAS, the Bath Township Board of Trustees adopted Township Resolution 2017-39 on December 4, 2017 requesting that the unincorporated territory of Bath Township become a Service Area of the Surface Water Management District, as those terms are defined in Chapter 942; and

WHEREAS, Section 942.03 of the Codified Ordinances requires this Council to adopt an Ordinance to establish the unincorporated territory of Bath Township as a Service Area within the Surface Water Management District; and

WHEREAS, Section 942.06 of the Codified Ordinances establishes the rate of \$4.00 per Equivalent Rate Unit ("ERU") per month as the Surface Water Management Service Charge to be paid by property owners within the Surface Water Management District unless a different rate is set by Council for a Service Area; and

WHEREAS, this Council believes that the rate of \$4.00 per ERU per month as the Surface Water Management Service Charge to be paid by property owners within the Bath Township Service Area is appropriate; and

WHEREAS, this Council has determined by reviewing all pertinent information that accepting the unincorporated territory of Bath Township into the Summit County Surface Water Management District, and establishing the Surface Water Management Service Charge, is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

## SECTION 1

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The unincorporated territory of Bath Township is hereby established as the Bath Township Service Area of the Summit County Surface Water Management District pursuant to Section 942.03 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit.

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SECTION 2
Property owners in the Bath Township Service Area will be charged \$4.00 per Equivalent Rate Unit ("ERU") per month as the Surface Water Management Service Charge in accordance with Section 942.06 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit.
SECTION 3
This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason that it immediately allows Bath Township and the County of Summit to begin addressing surface water issues in Bath Township.
SECTION 4
Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.
SECTION 5
It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
