A Resolution confirming an award by the Board of Control of a purchase contract with Henderson Products, under NJPA pricing, for one Hercules Snow Plow Hitch, one Hook/Lift Swap Loader, and one V-Box Spreader for a new cab and Chassis dump/plow truck, in an amount not to exceed \$54,371.00, for the Engineer, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held March 14, 2018, awarded a purchase contract with Henderson Products, under NJPA pricing, for one Hercules Snow Plow Hitch, one Hook/Lift Swap Loader, and one V-Box Spreader for a new cab and Chassis dump/plow truck, in an amount not to exceed \$54,371.00, subject to confirmation by County Council; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that the aforementioned purchase contract with Henderson Products, is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

## SECTION 1

 The award by the Board of Control of a purchase contract with Henderson Products, under NJPA pricing, for one Hercules Snow Plow Hitch, one Hook/Lift Swap Loader, and one V-Box Spreader for a new cab and Chassis dump/plow truck, in an amount not to exceed \$54,371.00, is hereby confirmed and the County Executive is hereby authorized to execute such purchase contract.

## **SECTION 2**

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately provide necessary equipment for the Engineer so that worn or auctioned fleet are replenished, in order to provide general maintenance, and snow and ice control.
