7 **A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to advertise for bids for a bomb robot for**  
8 **the Ashland County Bomb Squad, for an estimated total cost not to exceed \$97,915.00, for**  
9 **the Executive's Department of Law, Insurance and Risk Management-Division of Public**  
10 **Safety, and declaring an emergency.**

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12 WHEREAS, Section 177.05 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit  
13 requires this Council's authorization for the County Executive to advertise for bids; and

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15 WHEREAS, the County Executive wishes to advertise for bids for a bomb robot for the  
16 Ashland County Bomb Squad, for an estimated total cost not to exceed \$97,915.00; and

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18 WHEREAS, a copy of the bid specifications is on file in the Clerk of Council's office;

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21 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,  
22 that is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the Executive to  
23 advertise for bids for a bomb robot for the Ashland County Bomb Squad;

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25 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State  
26 of Ohio, that;

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28 SECTION 1

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30 The County Executive is authorized to advertise for bids for a bomb robot for the  
31 Ashland County Bomb Squad, for an estimated total cost not to exceed \$97,915.00.

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33 SECTION 2

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35 This Resolution is declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and welfare  
36 of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason that it authorizes the  
37 Executive to immediately advertise for bids for the bomb robot in order to procure the necessary  
38 equipment within the grant performance period.

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40 SECTION 3

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42 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take  
43 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take  
44 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

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6 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating  
7 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all  
8 deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were
