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7 **A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to advertise for bids for the Summit**
8 **County Children Services Training Center HVAC Improvement Project, in Council**
9 **District 4, for an estimated total cost not to exceed \$131,000.00, for the Executive’s**
10 **Department of Administrative Services-Physical Plants Division, and declaring an**
11 **emergency.**

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13 WHEREAS, Section 177.05 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit
14 requires this Council’s authorization for the County Executive to advertise for bids; and

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16 WHEREAS, the County Executive wishes to advertise for bids for the Children Services
17 Training Center HVAC Improvement Project, in Council District 4, for an estimated total cost
18 not to exceed \$131,000.00; and

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20 WHEREAS, a copy of the bid specifications is on file in the Clerk of Council’s office;

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23 WHEREAS this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
24 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the Executive to
25 advertise for bids for the Children Services Training Center HVAC improvement project;

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27 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
28 of Ohio, that:

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30 SECTION 1

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32 The County Executive is authorized to advertise for bids for the Children Services
33 Training Center HVAC Improvement Project, in Council District 4, for an estimated total cost
34 not to exceed \$131,000.00.

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36 SECTION 2

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38 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
39 welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason that it authorizes the
40 Executive to immediately advertise for bids for the aforementioned HVAC Improvement Project,
41 to prolong the service life of the HVAC system.

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45 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
46 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
47 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.
