7 **An Ordinance amending Section 199.02 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of**
8 **Summit, entitled "Expenses," to authorize the Child Support Enforcement Agency to**
9 **accept payment by financial transaction devices of costs related to any child support matter**
10 **before the Agency, for the Prosecutor, and declaring an emergency.**

12 WHEREAS, County Council previously adopted Ordinance No. 2007-424, enacting
13 Chapter 199 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit, entitled "Payments by
14 Financial Transaction Device", to authorize the County Clerk of Courts to accept payment by
15 financial transaction devices of title fees and court fees in accordance with Section 301.28 of the
16 Ohio Revised Code; and

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18 WHEREAS, Council subsequently adopted Ordinance No. 2009-055, which amended
19 Section 199.02 and 199.03 to allow for the use of financial transaction devices in multiple
20 County offices; and

22 WHEREAS, Council subsequently adopted Resolution No. 2013-125, which amended
23 Section 199.02 to allow for the use of financial transaction devices in the Court of Common
24 Pleas-Probate Division; and

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26 WHEREAS, the County Prosecutor's Child Support Enforcement Agency ("CSEA")
27 desires to allow payment by financial transaction device of costs related to any child support
28 matters before CSEA; and

30 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
31 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to amend Section 199.02 of
32 the Codified Ordinances to permit the CSEA to accept said payments by financial transaction
33 devices;

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35 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the County of Summit,
36 State of Ohio, that:

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38 SECTION 1

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40 Section 199.02 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit, entitled,
41 "Expenses," is hereby amended as follows:

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43 **199.02 EXPENSES.**

44 (a) Permitted Expenses; Clerk of Courts. The Clerk of Courts is authorized to receive
45 payments by financial transaction devices of the following expenses:

- 46 (1) Title fees; and
47 (2) Costs related to:
48 A. Any proceeding before the County of Summit Court of Common
49 Pleas, General Division; or
50 B. Any proceeding before the Ninth District Court of Appeals that is
51 filed in the County of Summit.
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4 SECTION 1 (Cont.)

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6 (b) Permitted Expenses; Juvenile Division. The County of Summit Court of
7 Common Pleas, Juvenile Division, is authorized to receive payments by financial transaction
8 devices of costs related to any proceeding before the Juvenile Division.

9 (c) Permitted Expenses; Real Estate Taxes. The County of Summit Fiscal Officer is
10 authorized to receive payments by financial transaction devices, including via the internet of real
11 estate taxes, assessments, delinquent fees, interest and any other related costs.

12 (d) Permitted Expenses; Building Standards. The County of Summit Executive
13 Department of Community and Economic Development, Division of Building Standards, is
14 authorized to receive payments by financial transaction devices of all registration, permit and
15 other associated and related fees and costs.

16 (e) Permitted Expenses; Animal Control. The County of Summit Executive,
17 Department of Administrative Services, Division of Animal Control, is authorized to receive
18 payments by financial transaction devices of all license, service and adoption fees, and any other
19 associated and related fees and costs.

20 (f) Permitted Expenses; Probate Division. The County of Summit Court of Common
21 Pleas, Probate Division; is authorized to receive payments by financial transaction devices of
22 costs related to any proceeding before the Probate Division.

23 (g) Permitted Expenses; Child Support Enforcement Agency. The County of Summit
24 Child Support Enforcement Agency is authorized to receive payments by financial transaction
25 devices of costs related to child support matters before the Child Support Enforcement Agency.

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27 SECTION 2

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29 This Ordinance is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
30 welfare of the residents of the County of Summit and for the further reason to immediately
31 authorize the County Prosecutor's Child Support Enforcement Agency ("CSEA") to accept
32 payment by financial transaction devices of costs related to child support matters before CSEA.

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34 SECTION 3

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36 Provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
37 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise it shall take effect
38 and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

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40 SECTION 4

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42 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating
43 to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all
44 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,
45 were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section
46 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
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


