RESOLUTION NO

A Resolution declaring it necessary to renew a tax levy of 2.25 mills and provide for an increase of 1 mill, to constitute a tax levy of 3.25 mills for the operation of the Summit County Children Services Board, established under Ohio Revised Code Chapter 5153 to support children services and the care and placement of children and to submit the question of the renewal and increase of that levy to the electors of this County at the election on November 6, 2018, for the Children Services Board, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the Council of the County of Summit (the "Council") is the taxing authority of the County pursuant to Article III, Section 3.01 of the County Charter; and

WHEREAS, the electors of this County on November 6, 2012 approved the renewal of a 2.25 mill levy, for the operation of the Summit County Children Services Board, established under Ohio Revised Code Chapter 5153, to support children services and the care and placement of children; and

WHEREAS, the authority to levy the aforesaid tax expires with the levy heretofore made on the 2019 tax duplicate for distribution to the County in 2020; and

WHEREAS, the amount of taxes which may be raised within the ten-mill limitation will be insufficient to provide for the aforesaid purpose, and it is necessary to renew the 2.25 mill levy and increase by 1 mill to constitute a tax levy of 3.25 mills pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Sections 5705.19, 5705.191 and 5705.24; and

WHEREAS, the County of Summit Social Services Advisory Board has recommended that the Council place upon the ballot at the election on November 6, 2018 the question of the renewal of a tax levy of 2.25 mills and increase of 1 mill to constitute a tax levy of 3.25 mills, for the aforesaid purpose, to run for a period of six (6) years, beginning with the 2019 tax list and duplicate, for collection in the years 2020 through 2025 inclusive; and

WHEREAS, this Council has adopted a Resolution pursuant to Section 5705.03 of the Revised Code declaring it necessary to renew and increase the aforesaid tax levy for the aforesaid period and requesting the County Fiscal Officer to certify to the taxing authority the total current tax valuation of the County and the dollar amount of revenue that would be generated by that 3.25 mill renewal levy and increase levy (the Initial Resolution); and

WHEREAS, the County Fiscal Officer has certified to the taxing authority as to the total current tax valuation of the County and the dollar amount of revenue that would be generated by that 2.25 mill renewal levy and increase of 1 mill to constitute a 3.25 mill tax levy; and

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WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that the Social Service Advisory Board's recommendation to place the aforementioned question on the ballot at the election on November 6, 2018, will provide for the continued operation of the Summit County Children Services Board, established under Ohio Revised Code Chapter 5153, to support children services and the care and placement of children and is therefore necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, two-thirds of all the members elected thereto concurring, that:

SECTION 1

The amount of taxes which may be raised within the ten-mill limitation by levies on the current tax duplicate will be insufficient to provide an adequate amount for the operation of Summit County Children Services Board, established under Ohio Revised Code Chapter 5153, to support children services and the care and placement of children after providing the normal and customary percentage of the total general fund appropriation for that purpose.

SECTION 2

It is necessary to levy a tax in excess of the ten-mill limitation for a period of six (6) years commencing with the tax duplicate of 2019 for collection in the years 2020 through 2025 inclusive, at a rate of 3.25 mills for the support of children services and the care and placement of children.

SECTION 3

The questions of renewing the existing 2.25 mill tax levy and providing for an increase of 1 mill to constitute a 3.25 mill levy for the purpose of the operation of the Summit County Children Services Board, established under Ohio Revised Code Chapter 5153, to support children services and the care and placement of children for a period of six (6) years, beginning with the 2019 tax list and duplicate, the proceeds of which levy first would be distributed in calendar year 2020, shall be submitted under the provisions of Sections 5705.19, 5705.191 and 5705.24 of the Ohio Revised Code to the electors of the County of Summit at the election to be held therein on November 6, 2018, as authorized by law. The election shall be held at the regular places of voting in the County as established by the Board of Elections of Summit County, Ohio, or otherwise, within the time provided by law and shall be conducted, canvassed and certified in the manner provided by law.

SECTION 5

The Clerk of Council is authorized and directed to certify to the Board of Elections of Summit County not later than August 8, 2018: (i) a copy of the Initial Resolution as defined in the preambles hereto; (ii) the certification by the County Fiscal Officer as to the total current tax valuation of the County and the dollar amount of revenue that would be generated by that 3.25 mill renewal with an increase levy; and (iii) a copy of this Resolution. This Council requests that the Board of Elections of Summit County give notice of the election and prepare the necessary ballots and supplies for the election in accordance with law.

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SECTION 6

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in order to place the question of the renewal of the aforesaid levy upon the ballot at the election on November 6, 2018, in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the County of Summit and for the further reason that it is necessary to provide for the continued operation of the Summit County Children Services Board, established under Ohio Revised Code Chapter 5153, to support children services and the care and placement of children.

SECTION 7

Provided this Resolution receives an affirmative vote of eight (8) members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

SECTION 8

ABSENT: Wilhite
