A Resolution confirming an award by the Board of Control of Change Order No. 1 to a professional service contract with Tri-County Jobs for Ohio's Graduates, for Summer Youth Employment Program monitoring services, for the period 5/1/18 through 9/30/18, in an amount not to exceed \$125,000.00 (a cumulative increase of 192%), for a total amount not to exceed \$190,000.00, for the Executive's Department of Job and Family Services, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, County Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2018-157, which awarded Summer Youth Employment Program ("SYEP") Monitoring Services Agreements with certain providers for monitoring services, work readiness skills training and other additional services, for the period of 5/1/18 through 9/30/18, in a total amount not to exceed \$270,000.00; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held June 13, 2018, awarded Change Order No. 1 to a professional service contract with one of the providers, Tri-County Jobs for Ohio's Graduates, for SYEP monitoring services for the period 5/1/18 through 9/30/18, in an amount not to exceed \$125,000.00 (a cumulative increase of 192%), for a total amount not to exceed \$190,000.00, subject to confirmation by County Council; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines after reviewing all pertinent information, that the aforementioned Change Order No. 1 to said professional service contract with Tri-County Jobs for Ohio's Graduates is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:
