7 **A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute, subject to the approval of the**  
8 **Board of Control, a renewal (second of four) of a professional service contract with Oriana**  
9 **House, Inc. for community corrections services, which shall include the operation of the**  
10 **County of Summit Community Alternative Sentencing Center, for a one year term, from**  
11 **1/1/19 through 12/31/19, in an amount not to exceed \$6,571,493.73, for the Executive's**  
12 **Department of Law, Insurance and Risk Management-Division of Public Safety and**  
13 **declaring an emergency.**

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15 WHEREAS, County Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2018-026, which  
16 confirmed an award by the Board of Control a professional service contract with Oriana House,  
17 Inc. for day reporting, driver intervention, home incarceration, multiple offender, pretrial  
18 services and residential community corrections programs, for the period 1/1/18 through  
19 12/31/18, in an amount not to exceed \$5,921,097.39, with four options to renew for an additional  
20 one-year term, with the cost of any renewal term to be equal to the increase in the Consumer  
21 Price Index or three percent, whichever is less; and

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23 WHEREAS, Council subsequently adopted Resolution No. 2018-026, which confirmed  
24 an award by the Board of Control for a renewal (first of four) of a professional service contract  
25 with Oriana House, Inc. for community corrections services, for a one year term, from 1/1/18  
26 through 12/31/18, in an amount not to exceed \$5,921,097.39; and

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28 WHEREAS, pending before this Council is a resolution which repeals Ordinance Nos.  
29 83-406 and 96-611 designating 40 East Glenwood Ave., Akron, Ohio 44304 as a County Jail  
30 Facility and pursuant to Section 307.932 of the Ohio Revised Code, redesignates and establishes  
31 40 East Glenwood Ave. as the County of Summit Community Alternative Sentencing Center  
32 ("CS-CASC"); and

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34 WHEREAS, Section 307.932 authorizes the operation of the CS-CASC by a nonprofit  
35 corporation; and

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37 WHEREAS, the County wishes to renew (second of four) the professional service  
38 contract with Oriana House, Inc. for community corrections services, which shall include the  
39 operation of the CS-CASC, for a one year term, from 1/1/19 through 12/31/19, in an amount not  
40 to exceed \$6,571,493.73; and

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42 WHEREAS, this Council has determined by reviewing all pertinent information that it is  
43 necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the County Executive to  
44 execute a renewal (second of four) of the aforementioned professional service contract with  
45 Oriana House, Inc., which shall include the operation of the CS-CASC;

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47 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State

4 SECTION 1

6 The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute, subject to the approval of the  
7 Board of Control, a renewal (second of four) of a professional service contract with Oriana  
8 House, Inc., for community corrections services, which shall include the operation of the County  
9 of Summit Community Alternative Sentencing Center ("CS-CASC"), for a one year term, from  
10 1/1/19 through 12/31/19, in an amount not to exceed \$6,571,493.73.

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12 SECTION 2

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14 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and  
15 welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately  
16 allow the provision of community corrections services, including the operation of the CS-CASC  
17 effective 1/1/19.

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19 SECTION 3

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21 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take  
22 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take  
23 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

25 SECTION 4

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27 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating  
28 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all  
29 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,  
30 were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section  
31 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
