7 **A Resolution adjusting existing appropriations, in the amount of \$25,000.00, from the**
8 **Benefits account to the Salaries account for the FFY2018 Victims of Crime Act Grant**
9 **Fund, for the Court of Common Pleas – Juvenile Division, and declaring an emergency.**

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11 WHEREAS, County Council previously adopted Resolution 2017-241, which authorized
12 the County Executive execute any documents necessary to accept an award from the State of
13 Ohio Attorney General's Office of a Federal Fiscal Year 2018 Victims of Crime Act grant, in the
14 amount of \$171,175.58, with a 25% local cash match requirement of \$42,793.89, and
15 appropriated said grant funds, for the Court of Common Pleas – Juvenile Division; and

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17 WHEREAS, it is necessary to adjust existing appropriations, in the amount of
18 \$25,000.00, from the Benefits account to the Salaries account, because the salary costs for the
19 grant period were underestimated; and

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21 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
22 that the aforementioned adjustment of appropriations is necessary and in the best interest of the
23 County of Summit;


