7 **A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute any documents necessary to**
8 **accept a Fiscal Year 2018 Treatment Drug Courts grant from the United States**
9 **Department of Health and Human Services, Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services**
10 **Administration, for the Valor Court Expansion and Enhancement Project, for the period**
11 **9/30/18 through 9/29/23, in the amount of \$1,813,193.00, with no local cash match**
12 **requirement, and appropriating \$348,331.00 of said grant funds for the period 9/30/18**
13 **through 9/29/19, for the County Court of Common Pleas – General Division, and declaring**
14 **an emergency.**

16 WHEREAS, the United States Department of Health and Human Services, through the
17 Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration (“SAMHSA”) has awarded a
18 Fiscal Year 2018 Treatment Drug Courts grant to the County of Summit Court of Common Pleas
19 – General Division for the Valor Court Expansion and Enhancement Project, in the amount of
20 \$1,813,193.00, with no local cash match requirement, for the period 9/30/18 through 9/29/23,
21 which is subject to performance review; and

23 WHEREAS, the SAMHSA grant program is designed to assist in the expansion of
24 comprehensive strategies for enhancing drug court capacity through substance abuse treatment
25 funds; and

27 WHEREAS, it is necessary to appropriate \$348,331.00 of said grant funds for the period
28 9/30/18 through 9/29/19, which is SAMHSA’s Fiscal Year 2018 Treatment Drug Courts grant’s
29 first project period; and

31 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
32 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the County
33 Executive to execute any documents necessary to accept the award through SAMHSA of the
34 Fiscal Year 2018 Treatment Drug Courts grant, in the amount of \$1,813,193.00, with no local
35 cash match requirement, for the period 9/30/18 through 9/29/23, and to appropriate said grant
36 funds, in the amount of \$348,331.00, for the period 9/30/18 through 9/29/19;

31 immediately appropriating \$348,331.00 of these grant funds in order to establish and provide
32 services through the Valor Court Expansion and Enhancement Project within the grant period.

38 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.


