7 **A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute any documents necessary to**
8 **accept an award from the State of Ohio Attorney General’s Office of a Federal Fiscal Year**
9 **2019 Victims of Crime Act grant, in the amount of \$214,461.68, with no local cash match**
10 **requirement, and a Federal Fiscal Year 2019 State Victims Assistance Act grant, in the**
11 **amount of \$3,286.10, with no local cash match requirement, both for the period of 10/1/18**
12 **through 9/30/19, and appropriating funds, for the Court of Common Pleas-Juvenile**
13 **Division, and declaring an emergency.**

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15 WHEREAS, the Court of Common Pleas-Juvenile Division, has received an award from
16 the State of Ohio Attorney General’s Office of a Federal Fiscal Year (“FFY”) 2019 Victims of
17 Crime Act (“VOCA”) grant in the amount of \$214,461.68, with a no local cash match
18 requirement, for the period 10/1/18 through 9/30/19; and

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20 WHEREAS, the Court of Common Pleas-Juvenile Division has also received an award
21 from the State of Ohio Attorney General’s Office of a FFY 2019 State Victims Assistance Act
22 (“SVAA”) grant, in the amount of \$3,286.10, with no local cash match requirement, for the
23 period 10/1/18 through 9/30/19, and for which the State of Ohio Attorney General’s Office
24 requires an accounting identity separate from the VOCA award; and

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26 WHEREAS, the VOCA and SVAA are annual grants which help to support salary and
27 benefits for two volunteer coordinators and a Guardian Ad Litem, all full time, providing
28 advocacy services to crime victims in Summit County; and

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30 WHEREAS, it is necessary to accept the award of the aforementioned FFY 2019 grants
31 from the State of Ohio Attorney General’s Office and to appropriate said grant funds; and

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33 WHEREAS, additional Reclaim Ohio grant funds, in the amount of \$25,000.00, are
34 available to supplement the FFY 2019 grant funds; and

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36 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
37 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the County
38 Executive to execute any documents necessary to accept the aforementioned grants from the
39 State of Ohio Attorney General’s Office and to appropriate funds;
