## SECTION 1

The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute a Cooperative Agreement with the DFA and the Civic whereby the County will provide owner's representative services to the DFA and the Civic during the undertaking of the Project. Said Cooperative Agreement is entitled the Cooperative Agreement for the Bowery Redevelopment, Building F, Building G and Civic Theater Restoration Projects, and a copy is attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein by reference. The County Executive is further authorized to make any modifications to said Cooperative Agreement which, in the County Executive's opinion are non-material and not contrary to the interest of the County, which determination shall be conclusively evidenced upon the County Executive's execution of the same.

## **SECTION 2**

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason that it is necessary to immediately authorize the County Executive to execute the aforementioned Cooperative Agreement so as to not unduly delay the Project.

## **SECTION 3**

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

## **SECTION 4**

It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
