7 **A Resolution approving the Downtown Akron Special Improvements District's Plan of**
8 **Services and authorizing the County Executive to execute a petition to approve the Plan of**
9 **Services, for the Executive's Department of Law and Risk Management, and declaring an**
10 **emergency.**

12 WHEREAS, this Council previously approved Resolution No. 98-719, which declared
13 the County's intent to participate in the Downtown Akron Special Improvements District
14 ("District") and permitted the inclusion of the County's real property located in downtown
15 Akron as a part of the District; and

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17 WHEREAS, this Council previously approved Resolution No. 99-310, which approved
18 the District's first five-year Plan of Services and authorized the Executive to execute a petition
19 approving the Plan of Services; and

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21 WHEREAS, this Council also previously approved Resolution No. 2004-109, which
22 approved the District's second five-year Plan of Services and authorized the Executive to
23 execute another petition approving and extending the Plan of Services; and

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25 WHEREAS, this Council also previously approved Resolution No. 2008-526, which
26 approved the District's third five-year Plan of Services and authorized the Executive to execute
27 another petition approving and extending the Plan of Services; and

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29 WHEREAS, this Council also previously approved Resolution No. 2013-516, which
30 approved the District's fourth five-year Plan of Services and authorized the Executive to execute
31 another petition approving and extending the Plan of Services; and

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33 WHEREAS, the District has developed a new five-year Plan of Services and has
34 requested that the County approve, and that the County Executive execute, a new petition
35 approving the Plan of Services; and

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37 WHEREAS, the Plan of Services will be financed with special assessments against the
38 real property within the District, including the real property owned by the County; and

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40 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
41 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to approve said Plan of
42 Services for the District and to authorize the County Executive to execute a petition approving
43 and extending the Plan of Services.

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45 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the County of Summit,
46 State of Ohio, that:

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50 The Downtown Akron Special Improvements District's Plan of Services, including the
51 assessment of the County's real property included in the District, is hereby approved and the
52 County Executive is hereby authorized to execute a petition approving and extending the Plan of

59 assessment for the Plan of Services is attached hereto as Exhibit B, both of which are
60 incorporated herein by reference.

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64 This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure in the interest of the
65 health, safety and welfare of the residents of the County of Summit and for the further reason to
66 immediately prevent any delay in the execution and filing of said petition for the Plan of Services
67 and the carrying-out of the Plan of Services.

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69 SECTION 3

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71 Provided this Resolution received the affirmative vote of at least eight members, it shall
72 take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive, otherwise, it shall take
73 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

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75 SECTION 4

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77 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating
78 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in open meetings of this Council and that all
79 deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that participated in such formal action
80 were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section
81 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


