7 **A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to advertise for bids for a specialized**  
8 **hazardous materials vehicle for the Summit County Type I Hazardous Materials Response**  
9 **Team, for an estimated total cost not to exceed \$285,000.00, for the Executive's Department**  
10 **of Law and Risk Management Division of Public Safety – Emergency Management Agency,**  
11 **and declaring an emergency.**

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13 WHEREAS, Section 177.05 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit  
14 requires this Council's authorization for the County Executive to advertise for bids; and

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16 WHEREAS, the County Executive wishes to advertise for bids for a specialized  
17 hazardous materials vehicle for the Summit County Type I Hazardous Materials Response Team,  
18 for an estimated total cost not to exceed \$285,000.00; and

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20 WHEREAS, a copy of the bid specifications is on file in the Clerk of Council's office;

23 WHEREAS this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information  
24 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the Executive to  
25 advertise for bids for the aforementioned specialized hazardous materials vehicle for the Summit  
26 County Type I Hazardous Materials Response Team;

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28 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State  
29 of Ohio, that:

31 SECTION 1

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33 The County Executive is authorized to advertise for bids for a specialized hazardous  
34 materials vehicle for the Summit County Type I Hazardous Materials Response Team, for an  
35 estimated total cost not to exceed \$285,000.00.

37 SECTION 2

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39 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and  
40 welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason that it authorizes the  
41 Executive to immediately advertise for the aforementioned necessary equipment for the Summit  
42 County Type I Hazardous Materials Response Team in order to so that the vehicle may be  
43 purchased and utilized as expeditiously as possible

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47 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take  
48 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take  
49 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.  
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


