A Resolution confirming an award by the Board of Control of a professional service contract with DLZ Ohio, Inc. for design work on behalf of the Cuyahoga Valley National Park for a pedestrian bridge over the Cuyahoga River near the new Boston Mills Visitor Center, in Council District 1, for an amount not to exceed \$230,613.00, for the Engineer, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its November 27, 2019 meeting, awarded a professional service contract with DLZ Ohio, Inc. for design work on behalf of the Cuyahoga Valley National Park for a pedestrian bridge over the Cuyahoga River near the new Boston Mills Visitor Center, in Council District 1, for an amount not to exceed \$230,613.00, subject to confirmation by County Council; and

WHEREAS, Transportation Alternative Program Funding from the Akron Metropolitan Area Transportation Study will provide funding for a pedestrian bridge over the Cuyahoga River near the new Boston Mills Visitor Center. The bridge will span the Cuyahoga River and will connect the parking lot, railroad crossing, and visitor center courtyard on the west with the old (soon to be abandoned) parking lot on the east with linkage to the Canal Tow Path; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that the aforementioned professional service contract with DLZ Ohio, Inc. is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1

The award by the Board of Control a professional service contract with DLZ Ohio, Inc. for design work on behalf of the Cuyahoga Valley National Park for a pedestrian bridge over the Cuyahoga River near the new Boston Mills Visitor Center, in Council District 1, for an amount not to exceed \$230,613.00, is hereby confirmed and the County Executive is hereby authorized to execute such professional service contract and any other necessary related documents.

SECTION 2

This Resolution is declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the County of Summit and for the further reason to immediately confirm the award of a necessary professional service contract to design a pedestrian bridge for the Cuyahoga Valley National Park.

SECTION 3

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.
