A Resolution declaring it necessary to renew an existing tax levy of eight-tenths (0.8) of a mill and provide for an increase of four-tenths (0.4) of a mill, to constitute a tax levy of one and two-tenths (1.2) mills to maintain and operate existing facilities and to expand physical facilities and educational programs in order to continue to provide zoological park services and facilities at the Akron Zoological Park, to increase the duration of the levy to ten years from seven years, and to submit the question of the renewal and increase of that levy to the electors of this County at the general election on November 3, 2020, for the Executive and the Council, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the Council of the County of Summit (the "Council") is the taxing authority of the County pursuant to Article III, Section 3.01 of the County Charter; and

WHEREAS, the Akron Zoological Park, a nonprofit corporation, operates and maintains a zoological park in the County (the "Akron Zoo"); and

WHEREAS, the electors of Summit County on November 5, 2013 approved the renewal of an eight-tenths (0.8) of a mill tax levy, for the purpose operating and capital expenses for the provision of zoological park services and facilities at the Akron Zoo; and

WHEREAS, the authority to levy the aforesaid tax expires with the levy heretofore made on the 2020 tax duplicate for distribution to the County in 2021; and

WHEREAS, the amount of taxes which may be raised within the ten-mill limitation will be insufficient to provide for the aforesaid purpose, and it is necessary to renew the .8 mill levy and increase by .4 mill to constitute a tax levy of 1.2 mills pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Sections 5705.19 and 5705.191; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of the Akron Zoological Park has recommended that this Council place upon the ballot at the general election on November 3, 2020 the question of the renewal of a tax levy of eight-tenths (0.8) of a mills and increase of four-tenths (0.4) of a mill, to constitute a tax levy of one and two-tenths (1.2) mills, for the aforesaid purpose, to increase the duration of the levy to ten years from seven years, for a period beginning with the 2021 tax list and duplicate, for collection in the years 2022 through 2031 inclusive; and

WHEREAS, this Council has adopted Resolution 2019-396 on October 28, 2019 pursuant to Section 5705.03 of the Revised Code declaring it necessary to renew and increase the aforesaid tax levy for the aforesaid period and requesting the County Fiscal Officer to certify to the taxing authority the total current tax valuation of the County and the dollar amount of revenue that would be generated by that of eight-tenths (0.8) of a mills and increase of fourtenths (0.4) of a mill, to constitute a tax levy of one and two-tenths (1.2) mills, (the Initial Resolution); and

WHEREAS, the County Fiscal Officer has certified to the taxing authority as to the total current tax valuation of the County and the dollar amount of revenue that would be generated by that eight-tenths (0.8) of a mill renewal levy and four-tenths (0.4) of a mill increase to constitute a one and two-tenths (1.2) mill tax levy; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that the Akron Zoological Park Board's recommendation to place the aforementioned question on the ballot at the general election on November 3, 2020, shall enable the Akron Zoological Park to maintain and operate the Akron Zoo, to develop the Akron Zoo, and to provide for the acquisition, disposition and care of animals to be exhibited at the Akron Zoo, and is therefore, necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, two-thirds of all the members elected thereto concurring, that:

## **SECTION 1**

The amount of taxes which may be raised within the ten-mill limitation by levies on the current tax duplicate will be insufficient to provide an adequate amount to maintain and operate existing facilities and to expand physical facilities and educational programs in order to continue to provide zoological park services and facilities at the Akron Zoo after providing the normal and customary percentage of the total general fund appropriation for that purpose.

## **SECTION 2**

It is necessary to levy a tax in excess of the ten-mill limitation for a period of ten (10) years commencing with the 2021 tax list and duplicate, for collection in the years 2022 through 2031 inclusive, at a rate of one and two-tenths (1.2) mills to maintain and operate existing facilities and to expand physical facilities and educational programs in order to continue to provide zoological park services and facilities at the Akron Zoological Park.

## **SECTION 3**

The questions of renewing the existing eight-tenths (0.8) of mill tax levy and providing for an increase of four-tenths (0.4) of a mill to constitute a one and two-tenths (1.2) mill levy and increase the duration to ten years from seven years to maintain and operate existing facilities and to expand physical facilities and educational programs in order to continue to provide zoological park services and facilities at the Akron Zoological Park for a period of ten (10) years, beginning with the 2021 tax list and duplicate, the proceeds of which levy first would be distributed in calendar year 2022, shall be submitted under the provisions of 5705.19 and 5705.191 of the Ohio Revised Code to the electors of the County of Summit at the general election to be held therein on November 3, 2020, as authorized by law. The election shall be held at the regular places of voting in the County as established by the Board of Elections of Summit County, Ohio, or otherwise, within the time provided by law and shall be conducted, canvassed and certified in the manner provided by law.
