Cleveland Massillon Road, Bath Township, Ohio 44333, Parcel No. 0403384, for a fee of 5% of the purchase price for a Non Co-Brokered Transaction or 6% of the purchase price for a Co-Brokered Transaction, for the Executive, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the County is the owner of certain real property located at 340 N. Cleveland Massillon Rd., Bath Township, Ohio 44333 ("Property"), that has historically been utilized by the Summit County Developmental Disabilities Board as a training center and workshop; and

WHEREAS, the Summit County Developmental Disabilities Board vacated the property in 2010 and no longer has a use for the property; and

WHEREAS, the County Executive partnered with the Summit County Developmental Disabilities Board in February of 2019 to begin marketing the property through resources available in its Department of Community and Economic Development; and

WHEREAS, these efforts have increased the exposure of the property, but have not generated successful leads on potential purchasers; and

WHEREAS, the Summit County Developmental Disabilities Board has passed Resolution #19-10-02 requesting the Executive to list the property with a real estate broker, attached as Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS, the County Executive and the Summit County Developmental Disabilities Board wish to list the property with Berkshire Hathaway Home Services Simon and Salhany Realty, Inc. to proactively market the property to potential purchasers; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County to authorize the County Executive to execute and enter into the aforementioned professional service contract.
