WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held November 13, 2019, awarded a professional service contract with Channel Maintenance Systems, LLC, for professional design services for Yellow Creek Streambank Repair and Landslide Mitigation Phase 1, in an amount not to exceed \$75,000.00, subject to confirmation by County Council; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines after reviewing all pertinent information that the aforementioned professional service contract with Channel Maintenance Systems, LLC is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

## SECTION 1

The award by the Board of Control of a professional service contract with Channel Maintenance Systems, LLC for professional design services for Yellow Creek Streambank Repair and Landslide Mitigation Phase 1, in an amount not to exceed \$75,000.00, is hereby confirmed and the County Executive is hereby authorized to execute said professional service contract.

## **SECTION 2**

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately authorize the aforementioned professional service contract so that the design phase for Yellow Creek can begin as expeditiously as possible to prevent road infrastructure and further erosion.

## **SECTION 3**

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

## **SECTION 4**

It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
