7 **A Resolution confirming an award by the Board of Control of a purchase contract with**  
8 **Finley Fire Equipment, for the purchase of self-contained breathing apparatus and**  
9 **accessories for the Mahoning County Type II Hazardous Materials Response Team, in an**  
10 **amount not to exceed \$82,760.00, for the Executive's Department of Law and Risk**  
11 **Management-Division of Public Safety, and declaring an emergency.**

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13 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held October 23, 2019, awarded a  
14 purchase contract with Finley Fire Equipment, for the purchase of self-contained breathing  
15 apparatus and accessories for the Mahoning County Type II Hazardous Materials Response  
16 Team, in an amount not to exceed \$82,760.00, subject to confirmation by County Council; and

18 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,  
19 that the aforementioned purchase contract with Finley Fire Equipment is necessary and in the  
20 best interest of the County of Summit;

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22 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the County of Summit, State  
23 of Ohio, that:

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25 SECTION 1

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27 The award by the Board of Control of a purchase contract Finley Fire Equipment, for the  
28 purchase of self-contained breathing apparatus and accessories for the Mahoning County Type II  
29 Hazardous Materials Response Team, in an amount not to exceed \$82,760.00, is hereby  
30 confirmed and the County Executive is hereby authorized to execute such purchase contract.

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32 SECTION 2

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34 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of health, safety and  
35 welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately  
36 provide necessary equipment for the Mahoning County Type II Hazardous Materials Response  
37 Team.

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39 SECTION 3

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41 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take  
42 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take  
43 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

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45 SECTION 4

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47 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating  
48 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all  
49 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,  
50 were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section  
51 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.  
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
