7 **A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute any documents necessary to**
8 **accept an award from the State of Ohio Attorney General's Office of a Federal Fiscal Year**
9 **2020 Victims of Crime Act grant, in the amount of \$199,679.39, with no local cash match**
10 **requirement, and a Federal Fiscal Year 2020 State Victims Assistance Act grant, in the**
11 **amount of \$3,286.10, with no local cash match requirement, both for the period of 10/1/19**
12 **through 9/30/20, and additional Reclaim Ohio funds, in the amount of \$35,000.00, with no**
13 **local cash match requirement, for the Court of Common Pleas-Juvenile Division, and**
14 **declaring an emergency.**

16 WHEREAS, the Court of Common Pleas-Juvenile Division, has received an award from
17 the State of Ohio Attorney General's Office of a Federal Fiscal Year ("FFY") 2020 Victims of
18 Crime Act ("VOCA") grant in the amount of \$199,679.39, with a no local cash match
19 requirement, for the period 10/1/19 through 9/30/20; and

21 WHEREAS, the Court of Common Pleas-Juvenile Division has also received an award
22 from the State of Ohio Attorney General's Office of a FFY 2020 State Victims Assistance Act
23 ("SVAA") grant, in the amount of \$3,286.10, with no local cash match requirement, for the
24 period 10/1/19 through 9/30/20, and for which the State of Ohio Attorney General's Office
25 requires an accounting identity separate from the VOCA award; and

27 WHEREAS, the VOCA and SVAA are annual grants which help to support salary and
28 benefits for two volunteer coordinators and a Guardian Ad Litem, all full time, providing
29 advocacy services to crime victims in Summit County; and

31 WHEREAS, it is necessary to accept the award of the aforementioned FFY 2020 grants
32 from the State of Ohio Attorney General's Office; and

34 WHEREAS, additional Reclaim Ohio grant funds, in the amount of \$35,000.00, with no
35 local cash match requirement, are available to supplement the FFY 2020 grant funds; and

37 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
38 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the County
39 Executive to execute any documents necessary to accept the aforementioned grants from the
40 State of Ohio Attorney General's Office and the additional Reclaim Ohio funds;

42 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State

47 The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute any documents necessary to accept

50 requirement, for the period 10/1/19 through 9/30/20.

7 an award of a FFY 2020 State Victims Assistance Act ("SVAA") grant from the State of Ohio
8 Attorney General's Office in the amount of \$3,286.10, with no local cash match requirement, for
9 the period, 10/1/19 through 9/30/20.

11 SECTION 3

13 The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute any documents necessary to accept
14 an award of additional Reclaim Ohio funds, in the amount of \$35,000.00 with no local cash
15 match requirement, which will supplement the FFY 2020 VOCA and SVAA grants.

19 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
20 welfare of the residents of the County of Summit and for the further reason to immediately
21 authorize the acceptance of the awards of the FFY 2020 VOCA grant and FFY 2020 SVAA
22 grant from the State of Ohio Attorney General's Office for the respective grant periods
23 commencing 10/1/19 and the additional Reclaim Ohio funds to supplement said grants.

27 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
28 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
29 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

33 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating
34 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all
35 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,

37 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

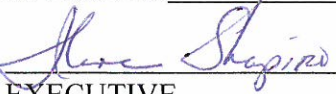
