7 **A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute a Partner Design and**
8 **Construction Agreement with Cuyahoga Valley National Park concerning the design and**
9 **construction of the Cuyahoga River Pedestrian Bridge at the Boston Mill Visitor Center**
10 **located in Boston Township, in Council District 1, for the Engineer, and declaring an**
11 **emergency.**

13 WHEREAS, the County Engineer's Office applied for and received Transportation
14 Alternative Set Aside federal grant funding on behalf of Cuyahoga Valley National Park for the
15 construction of a pedestrian bridge over the Cuyahoga River at the newly constructed Boston
16 Mill Visitor Center ("Project") located near the intersection of Boston Mills Road and Riverview
17 Road located in Boston Township, in Council District 1; and

18
19 WHEREAS, an intergovernmental agreement is needed to outline the scope of work and
20 responsibilities for the County of Summit and Cuyahoga Valley National Park in overseeing the
21 planning, design, and construction of the Project, as detailed in Exhibit A; and

23 WHEREAS, the County of Summit, as sponsor of the grant application and as an
24 authorized Local Public Agency for the Ohio Department of Transportation's Local Let Process
25 will act as administrator for the Project with Cuyahoga Valley National Park responsible for the
26 local share of funding for the Project; and

28 WHEREAS, this Council has determined by reviewing all pertinent information that it is
29 necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the Executive to enter
30 into a Partner Design and Construction Agreement with Cuyahoga Valley National Park to
31 oversee aforementioned project;

33 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
34 of Ohio, that;

38 The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute a Partner Design and Construction
39 Agreement with Cuyahoga Valley National Park for the design and construction of a pedestrian
40 bridge over the Cuyahoga River near the Boston Mill Visitor Center, located in Boston
41 Township, in Council District 1, which is attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated fully
42 herein, with such modifications and revisions as shall be in furtherance of the provisions of said
43 Agreement and not substantially adverse to the County, all of which shall be conclusively
44 evidenced by the execution thereof by the County Executive.


