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31 10) Up to seven representatives of healthcare-centered organizations and/or community
32 advocates committed to elder care and/or the care of individuals with developmental
33 disabilities or who otherwise have expertise in a related field

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35 SECTION 2

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37 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
38 welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit and for the further purpose of immediately
39 amending Resolution 2019-315 to include up to seven additional membership spots to increase
40 participation of community elder care advocates and individuals with other related areas of
41 expertise.

46 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
