7 **A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to advertise for bids for an HVAC upgrade**
8 **project at the Medical Examiner's Office using a Project Labor Agreement, in Council**
9 **District 4, for an estimated total cost not to exceed \$805,000.00, for the Executive's**
10 **Department of Administrative Services-Physical Plants Division, and declaring an**
11 **emergency.**

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13 WHEREAS, Section 177.05 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit
14 requires this Council's authorization for the County Executive to advertise for bids; and

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16 WHEREAS, the County Executive wishes to advertise for bids for an HVAC upgrade
17 project at the Medical Examiner's Office using a Project Labor Agreement, in Council District 4,
18 for an estimated total cost not to exceed \$805,000.00; and

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20 WHEREAS, a copy of the bid specs are on file in the Clerk of Council's office; and

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22 WHEREAS this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
23 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the County
24 Executive to advertise for bids for an HVAC upgrade project at the Medical Examiner's Office;

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26 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
27 of Ohio, that:

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29 SECTION 1

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31 The County Executive is authorized to advertise for bids for an HVAC upgrade project at
32 the Medical Examiner's Office using a Project Labor Agreement, in Council District 4, for an
33 estimated total cost not to exceed \$805,000.00.

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35 SECTION 2

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37 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
38 welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason that it authorizes the
39 Executive to immediately advertise for bids for the aforementioned HVAC project to prevent
40 further deterioration.

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44 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
45 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
46 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.
