A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute an intergovernmental agreement with the City of Hudson for sharing costs for the design by Environmental Design Group of a Pump Station and Forcemain as part of the Hudson Downtown Redevelopment – Phase 2 Project, located in the City of Hudson, in Council District 3, at a cost to the County not to exceed \$19,937.93, and appropriating funds, for the Executive's Department of Sanitary Sewer Services, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the County of Summit and the City of Hudson wish to enter into an intergovernmental agreement, which is attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein by reference, to participate in cost sharing agreement for the design by Environmental Design Group of a Pump Station and Forcemain as part of the Hudson Downtown Redevelopment – Phase 2 Project (the "Project"), at a cost to the County not to exceed \$19,937.93; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held September 18, 2019, awarded a professional service contract with Environmental Design Group, for the County's proportional share of the Project's cost, in an amount not to exceed \$19,937.93; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 177.21 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit, only the approval of County Council is required for intergovernmental agreements; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to appropriate funds, in the amount of \$19,937.93, to fund the design work by Environmental Design Group for the aforementioned Project; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the County Executive to execute the aforementioned intergovernmental agreement with the City of Hudson, and to appropriate funds;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

### SECTION 1

The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute an intergovernmental agreement with the City of Hudson for sharing costs for the design by Environmental Design Group of a Pump Station and Forcemain as part of the Hudson Downtown Redevelopment – Phase 2 Project, located in the City of Hudson, in Council District 3 (the "Project"), at a cost to the County not to exceed \$19,937.93.
