7 **A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to advertise for bids for Non-Emergency**
8 **Medical Transportation providers, for an estimated total cost not to exceed \$3,500,000.00,**
9 **for the Executive's Department Job and Family Services, and declaring an emergency.**

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11 WHEREAS, the County Executive's Department of Job and Family Services coordinates
12 and monitors the Non-Emergency Medical Transportation ("NET") services for eligible Summit
13 County Medicaid clients through NET providers via portal-to-portal-to-portal transportation,
14 which is funded by federal pass-through Medicaid dollars; and

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16 WHEREAS, Section 177.05 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit
17 requires this Council's authorization for the County Executive to advertise for bids; and

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19 WHEREAS, the County Executive wishes to advertise for bids for NET providers for an
20 estimated total cost not to exceed \$3,500,000.00; and

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22 WHEREAS, a copy of the bid specifications is on file in the Clerk of Council's office;
23 and

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25 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
26 that is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the Executive to
27 advertise for bids for NET providers;

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29 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
30 of Ohio, that;

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34 The County Executive is authorized to advertise for bids for Non-Emergency Medical
35 Transportation providers, for an estimated total cost not to exceed \$3,500,000.00.

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37 SECTION 2

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39 This Resolution is declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and welfare
40 of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason that it authorizes the
41 Executive to immediately advertise for bids necessary so that Non-Emergency Medical
42 Transportation services may be provided during the grant period.

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44 SECTION 3

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46 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
47 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
48 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.
