7 **A Resolution confirming an award by the Board of Control of a purchase contract with**  
8 **Metro Regional Transit Authority, as a Best Practical Source, to provide transportation to**  
9 **employment and training related activities for work mandated recipients for the period**  
10 **10/1/19 through 9/30/20, in an amount not to exceed \$125,000.00, for the Executive's**  
11 **Department of Job and Family Services, and declaring an emergency.**

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13 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held August 14, 2019, awarded a  
14 purchase contract with Metro Regional Transit Authority, as a Best Practical Source, to provide  
15 transportation to employment and training related activities for work mandated recipients, for the  
16 period 10/1/19 to 9/30/20, in an amount not to exceed \$125,000.00, subject to confirmation by  
17 County Council; and

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19 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information  
20 that the aforementioned purchase contract with Metro Regional Transit Authority is necessary  
21 and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

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23 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State  
24 of Ohio, that:

26 SECTION 1

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28 The award by the Board of Control of a purchase contract with Metro Regional Transit  
29 Authority, as a Best Practical Source, to provide transportation to employment and training  
30 related activities for work mandated recipients for the period 10/1/19 through 9/30/20, in an  
31 amount not to exceed \$125,000.00, is hereby confirmed and the County Executive is hereby  
32 authorized to execute said purchase contract and any necessary related documents.

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34 SECTION 2

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36 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and  
37 welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately  
38 provide for transportation services effective 10/1/19.

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42 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take  
43 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take  
44 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.
