An Ordinance amending Section 339.12 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit, entitled "Bridge Weight Limits," to place a load limit on the Wright Road Bridge over Pigeon Creek located in Copley Township, in Council District 5, and to remove a load limit on the West Bath Road Bridge over the Cuyahoga River, located in the City of Akron, in Council District 4, for the Engineer, and declaring an emergency.				
WHEREAS, Section 339.12 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit entitled "Bridge Weight Limits," limits the gross weight of vehicles authorized to travel on certain bridges that are inspected by the County Engineer; and				
WHEREAS, due a recent bridge inspection and load rating conducted by Arcadis U.S. Inc, the Engineer has concluded that a load limit should be placed on the Wright Road Bridge over Pigeon Creek, located in Copley Township, in Council District 5; and				
WHEREAS, the West Bath Road Bridge over the Cuyahoga River, located in the City of Akron, is under construction and closed to traffic, with the project contractor planning to reopen the rehabilitated bridge in October of 2019, allowing the bridge to carry a full legal load; and				
WHEREAS, the placement and removal of load limits of bridges requires the amendment of Section 339.12; and				
WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that amending Section 339.12 is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit for the aforementioned reasons;				
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that;				
SECTION 1				
Section 339.12 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit, entitled "Bridge Weight Limits," is hereby amended as follows:

SECTION 1 (Cont.)		
(d) Whoever violates any provision of this section is guilty of a minor misdemeanor on a first offense; on a second offense within one year after the first offense, the person is guilty of a misdemeanor of the fourth degree; on each subsequent offense within one year after the second offense, the person is guilty of a misdemeanor of the third degree."		

SECTION 2

This Ordinance is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately amend Section 339.12 allowing local officials to enforce a bridge load limit and keep Summit County motorists safe.

SECTION 3

Provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

SECTION 4

It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
