A Resolution appropriating funds, in the amount of \$350,000.00 for the Sheriff's Equitable Sharing Agreement and Certification Fund and authorizing the deposit of \$80,000.00 for the Law Enforcement Operations and Investigations segregated account, for the Sheriff, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the Sheriff has historically maintained a segregated bank account for the deposit and expenditure of funds derived from asset forfeitures received through the U.S. Department of Justice and the Department of the Treasury Equitable Sharing Programs; and

WHEREAS, the 2018 Guide to Equitable Sharing for State, Local, and Tribal Law Enforcement Agencies prescribed new guidance for Proper Bookkeeping Procedures and Internal Controls, as follows:

Section VI(A) The state or local participating law enforcement agency must:

(1) Maintain equitable sharing funds with the same entity that maintains the agency's appropriated funds and administers procurement actions. Bank accounts, checkbooks, purchase cards, and other financial instruments or documents must be maintained in the same manner as appropriated funds.

WHEREAS, adherence to Section VI(A)(1) requires moving the Sheriff's segregated bank account funds into the County's general depository and establishing and appropriating a Banner Fund for the Sheriff's Equitable Sharing Agreement and Certification Fund; and

WHEREAS, in order to provide for the efficient operations of Sheriff investigations and in order to adhere to Section V(B)(1)(a) establishing the permissible use of equitable funds for law enforcement operations and investigations, it is necessary to authorize the deposit of \$80,000.00 in a segregated bank account for the purpose of funding said operations with local funds and submitting these expenses for reimbursement; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that the aforementioned appropriations and deposit of funds are necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;
