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A Resolution appropriating funds, in the amount of \$60,000.00 for the Prosecutor's Equitable Sharing Agreement and Certification Fund, for the Prosecutor, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the Prosecutor has historically maintained a segregated bank account for the deposit and expenditure of funds derived from asset forfeitures received through the U.S. Department of Justice and the Department of the Treasury Equitable Sharing Programs; and

WHEREAS, the 2018 Guide to Equitable Sharing for State, Local, and Tribal Law Enforcement Agencies prescribed new guidance for Proper Bookkeeping Procedures and Internal Controls, as follows:

Section VI(A) The state or local participating law enforcement agency must:

(1) Maintain equitable sharing funds with the same entity that maintains the agency's appropriated funds and administers procurement actions. Bank accounts, checkbooks, purchase cards, and other financial instruments or documents must be maintained in the same manner as appropriated funds.

WHEREAS, adherence to Section VI(A)(1) requires moving the Prosecutor's segregated bank account funds into the County's general depository and establishing and appropriating a Banner Fund for the Prosecutor's Equitable Sharing Agreement and Certification Fund; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that the aforementioned appropriations are necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:
